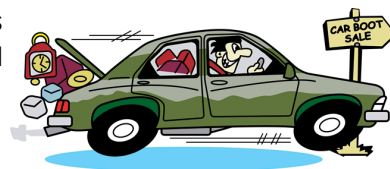
Drama Workshop

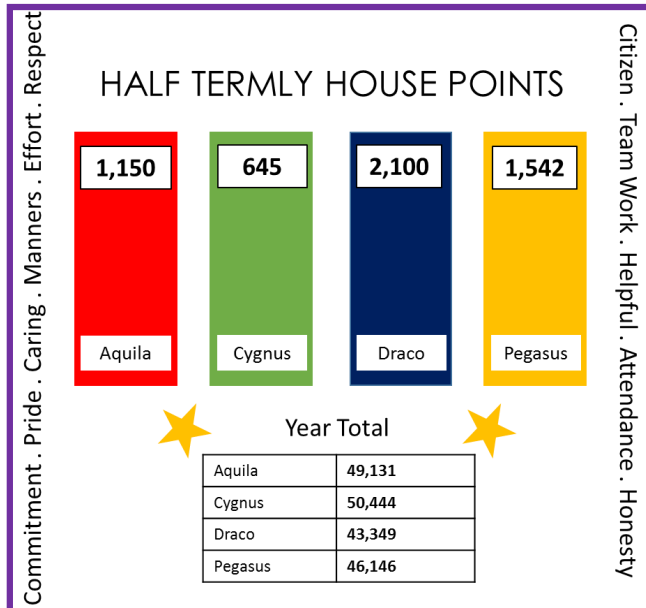
