Re: Year 11 Provision - Coronavirus (COVID-19)

As the Covid-19 outbreak continues and following a further update from Central Government on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> March, schools will continue to remain open for as long as possible. Therefore, it is essential that lessons and Period 6 sessions will continue to run as normal to support the students with their preparations for the upcoming examinations.

We are aware that the situation is filled with uncertainty and are conscious that this may change quickly. Understandably this can therefore create feelings of anxiety for all parents, carers and students, particularly those in Year 11. We would like to take this opportunity to reassure you that Year 11 will remain our priority and the highest level of support and guidance for the students will remain even if the situation does change.

In the event of either a partial or full school closure, plans are already in place to ensure students will gain access to work and ongoing support. Students will be provided with remote access to work and resources via our online platform RMuNify. Students can access this system through their school email account and can maintain regular communication with their class teachers. Any students without remote access will be provided with hard copies of all necessary resources.

With regards to the examinations themselves, we will remain guided by the Government and The OAT Trust to ensure all students are provided with the best possible provision in preparation for their exams. Unfortunately, we cannot provide any further information at this stage but will endeavor to provide parents, carers and students with any updates as soon as we have them.

A huge thank you for your support in this uncertain time and again continue to assure you that we will do everything possible to ensure our students get the best possible care and support throughout this period.
