Your child has been selected as part of a small team of students to take part in a Higher Horizons project. Working in collaboration with Stoke-on-Trent City Council on a public health issue, Higher Horizons+ inspire learners to consider higher education.

Students will learn about the dangers and social impact of smoking and create their own video production on the issue at Staffordshire University.

Day 1 will take place in OHA on Tuesday 26th March where students will meet with substance misuse officers to discuss the risks associated with smoking, and also liaise with current film and media students on how to plan for their video production. Normal uniform is required for the day.
