Library Competition

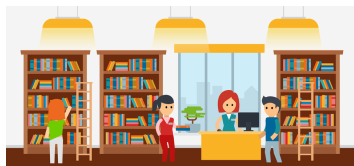
This month's competition is to make a poster to promote the library.

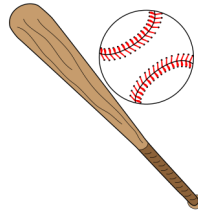

The Head's Lines

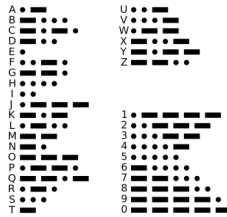

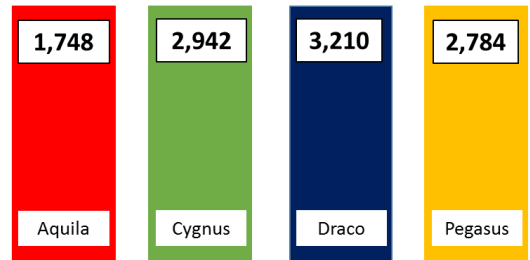
