Christmas Card Competition

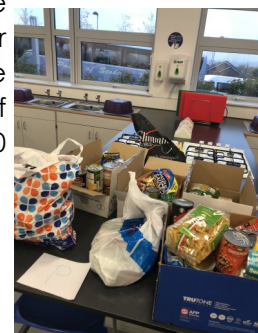
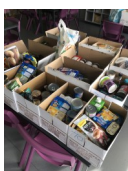
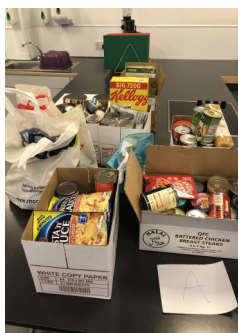
